A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the United States Department of Labor Through the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium for Funds in the Amount of \$811,300 to Support the King

County Neighborhood Youth Corps In-School and Summer Youth Projects

WHEREAS, The Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended provides for the award of grants by the United States Department of Labor, and

WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to support employment and training programs for low-income youth residing in King County, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$811,300 to the United States Department of Labor through the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium on behalf of King County;
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Department of Labor;
- 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
- 5. The United States of America, Department of Labor, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
