A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to grant an easement in favor of the Puget Sound Power & Light Co.

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Power and Light Company has made plans to install, maintain, and replace electric transmission and/or distribution lines on certain lands owned by the County, known as the Factoria Solid Waste Transfer Station, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be of mutual benefits to the citizens of King County and to Puget Sound Power and Light Company to grant to Puget Sound Power and Light Company an easement over, upon, across, and under the lands described herein, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement be granted,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary electric transmission line easement, granting to the Puget Sound Power and Light Company the easement, over, upon, cross and under the following described property situated in King County, State of Washington:

The West 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 10, Twp 24 No., Rge 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington.

A Right of Way thirty (30) ft. in width having fifteen (15) ft. of such width on each side of a centerline described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east line of the above described property, lying 25 ft. North of the S.E. corner thereof; thence running West parallel with the South line of said property to a point on the West line of said property, lying 25 ft. North of the S.W. corner thereof; said point on said West line being the terminus of the centerline herein described.
