

MOTION NO. 1808

1 A MOTION expressing support for joint participation  
2 by King County and suburban jurisdictions in an  
3 application for funds under the Housing and  
4 Community Development Act of 1974 and outlining  
5 guidelines relative to planning and distribution  
6 of funds.

7 BE IT MOVED that the King County Council hereby expresses  
8 its support for joint participation by King County with eligible  
9 suburban jurisdictions in an application for block grant funds  
10 under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and  
11 acknowledges and encourages this precedent-setting opportunity  
12 for cooperative effort in behalf of county citizens.

13 BE IT FURTHER MOVED that the Council approves the following  
14 guidelines as a basis for joint planning and the distribution of  
15 funds:

16 1. A joint policy committee be established comprised of the  
17 county executive, two members of the council, and three elected  
18 representatives of the suburban jurisdictions, and said joint  
19 policy committee shall review and recommend all policy including  
20 allocation of funds.

21 2. The monies be divided into two funds, one designated for  
22 the county and the second for the incorporated areas, according  
23 to the monies brought to the fund based on population, poverty  
24 and overcrowding, provided that consideration be given in  
25 subsequent years to the advantages of pooling all monies into a  
26 single fund.

27 3. In determining the portions of monies attributable to  
28 population and need characteristics under 2. above, a minimum of  
29 fifty (50) percent of all monies be assigned to the two funds  
30 based on need.

31 4. The county utilize its funds for eligible activities by  
32 distributing:

33 a. that portion of the monies brought to the fund based on  
population to the unincorporated area, and

1           b. that portion of the monies brought to the fund based on  
2 need characteristics according to need without regard to  
3 boundaries of eligible suburban jurisdictions.

4           5. The suburban jurisdictions utilize their funds for  
5 eligible activities by distributing

6           a. that portion of the monies brought to the fund based on  
7 each jurisdiction's population back to each jurisdiction

8           b. that portion of the monies brought to the fund based on  
9 need characteristics according to need within incorporated areas.


10          6. The receipt of funds would be contingent upon

11           a. acceptance of the Housing Assistance Plan as required by  
12 the Act, and


13           b. citizen involvement in planning as required by the Act.
