

MOTION NO. 1811

A MOTION declaring Tahoua, Niger, to be King County's Sister County and supporting Project Tahoua.

WHEREAS, the drought stricken countries of Africa are struggling to provide their citizens with the necessities of life, and

WHEREAS, thousands of lives will be lost if the more fortunate countries of the world do not come to their assistance, and

WHEREAS, CARE has offered to work with King County employees to aid the County of Tahoua in Niger, and

WHEREAS, Project Tahoua has been organized to accomplish this purpose,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County that:

1. Tahoua is declared to be King County's Sister County;
2. County employees are encouraged to support Project Tahoua so that they might acquaint themselves with the world food crisis and contribute to CARE's humanitarian work in Niger.
3. The King County Council encourages other units of government and the citizens of King County and the State of Washington to join in the effort to aid the people of Niger and its neighboring countries.
