

1 A MOTION authorizing one Housing & Community
2 Development Act position in the Public
3 Employment Program.

4 WHEREAS, Ordinance 2112 appropriates \$1,277,100 to the
5 Public Employment Program commencing July 1, 1974, through March
6 31, 1975, and

7 WHEREAS, King County is entitled to receive up to 9 million
8 dollars over the next three years under the Housing and
9 Community Development Act of 1974, and

10 WHEREAS, extensive plans and applications must be prepared
11 and adopted by the Council prior to March 1, 1975, and then
12 updated each year thereafter, and

13 WHEREAS, funds to prepare these plans have not been provided
14 in either the current budget or the 1975 Council budget request,

15 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 The Council Administrator is authorized and directed to
17 establish the following Housing and Community Development position
18 funded through the Public Employment and Comprehensive Employment
19 Training Act:

20 1 Planner III

21 Personnel hired to fill this position will be hired in
22 accordance with all regulations and policies of the Public
23 Employment Program.

24 The Council Administrator and the staff hired pursuant to
25 this motion shall prepare, as a matter of first priority, answers
26 to the following questions which shall be reviewed by the
27 Community and Environmental Development Committee:

28 1. What procedures will be implemented to provide adequate
29 and early opportunity for the Council to consider policy decisions
30 relating to the Housing and Community Development Act, prior to
31 the formal completion of plans and application for funds?
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1 2. By what specific date, prior to the completion of plans
2 and applications, will the Council consider the policy implication
3 of proposed County programs or activities which may be phased out
4 by this Act? What will be the expected impact? Implication?

5 3. What new authorities are available to urban counties
6 compared to existing programs and authorities which may be
7 considered for phasing out?

8 4. Under the Housing and Community Development Act, what new
9 relationships are possible with special and general units of
10 government?

11 5. What indicators of community development need will be
12 developed in completing plans and applications?

13 6. What guidelines will be used in developing community
14 objectives?

15 7. What methods will be used to prioritize projects?

16 8. What is the advisability of using these funds as match
17 for other federal monies with no dollar commitment by local
18 jurisdictions?

19 9. What is the role of the suburban legislative bodies in the
20 process?

21 10. What are the possible methods of distribution among
22 jurisdictions?

23 11. How will the requirements of the Housing and Community
24 Development Act be incorporated into the ongoing planning process
25 of the County so that activities related to this act are not
26 treated uniquely in coming years?
