WHEREAS, Ordinance 2112 appropriates \$1,277,100 to the Public Employment Program commencing July 1, 1974, through March 31, 1975, and

A MOTION authorizing one Housing & Community

Development Act position in the Public

WHEREAS, King County is entitled to receive up to 9 million dollars over the next three years under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, and

WHEREAS, extensive plans and applications must be prepared and adopted by the Council prior to March 1, 1975, and then updated each year thereafter, and

WHEREAS, funds to prepare these plans have not been provided in either the current budget or the 1975 Council budget request,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council Administrator is authorized and directed to establish the following Housing and Community Development position funded through the Public Employment and Comprehensive Employment Training Act:

## 1 Planner III

Personnel hired to fill this position will be hired in accordance with all regulations and policies of the Public Employment Program.

The Council Administrator and the staff hired pursuant to this motion shall prepare, as a matter of first priority, answers to the following questions which shall be reviewed by the Community and Environmental Development Committee:

1. What procedures will be implemented to provide adequate and early opportunity for the Council to consider policy decisions relating to the Housing and Community Development Act, prior to the formal completion of plans and application for funds?

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- 2. By what specific date, prior to the completion of plans and applications, will the Council consider the policy implication of proposed County programs or activities which may be phased out by this Act? What will be the expected impact? Implication?
- 3. What new authorities are available to urban counties compared to existing programs and authorities which may be considered for phasing out?
- 4. Under the Housing and Community Development Act, what new relationships are possible with special and general units of government?
- 5. What indicators of community development need will be developed in completing plans and applications?
- 6. What guidelines will be used in developing community objectives?
  - 7. What methods will be used to prioritize projects?
- 8. What is the advisability of using these funds as match for other federal monies with no dollar commitment by local jurisdictions?
- 9. What is the role of the suburban legislative bodies in the process?
- 10. What are the possible methods of distribution among jurisdictions?
- 11. How will the requirements of the Housing and Community
  Development Act be incorporated into the ongoing planning process
  of the County so that activities related to this act are not
  treated uniquely in coming years?
