MOTION NO. 1841

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to Execute and Submit a Grant Application to the Department of Social and Health Services for Funds in the Amount of \$270,000 to Support the Contract Services Project - King County Adult Probation Subsidy Plan.

WHEREAS, The Adult Probation Subsidy Act provides for the award of grants by the Department of Social and Health Services to counties, to increase local rehabilitative resources, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the need to reduce the reconviction rate and develop local resources for probationers, to reduce the need for institutional commitment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Social and Health Services for funds in the amount of \$270,000 on behalf of King County;
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.

- 5. That the United States of America, Department of Social and Health Services, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VIIof the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- 6. Following official notification of grant award and prior to the beginning of planned activities; the Executive shall notify the Chairman of the Operations and Judiciary Committee, in writing, of any substantive changes in the approved document necessitated by funding source review. The Operations and Judiciary Committee shall then prepare a motion authorizing said program changes.
- 7. No funds shall be appropriated for any planned activity unless the proposed appropriation is accompanied by a "Memorandum of Agreement", prepared by the Executive. The "Memorandum of Agreement" shall clearly and concisely state the quantitative objectives of the planned activity. The agreement shall state the means and methods to be used, including time frames, in evaluating the ability of the program sponsor to accomplish stated objectives.
