WHEREAS, the Medina Foundation provides for the award of grants to private and public agencies; funds for the planning and design of the Human Services Need Assessment/Program Evaluation Project, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide, as support to this program \$1,000 as in-kind match,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$5,450 to the Medina Foundation, on behalf of King County;
- 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Medina Foundation;
