A MOTION relating to the analysis and report by the University of Washington, Institute for Environmental Studies, on the R.I.B.C.O. recommendations compiled by consultants under contract to Metro; and recognizing the expenditure of two thousand dollars from the Road Project Formulation (50203) for the preparation thereof.

WHEREAS, studies have been performed on water resource, water quality, solid waste, and urban runoff and drainage by consultants under contract to Metro with participation of local governments, including King County, and

WHEREAS, it became evident to the Basin Environment

Committee (B.E.C.) and the River Basin Coordinating Committee

(R.I.B.C.O.) that a review of the various plans by the University

of Washington Institute for Environmental Studies, at a cost of

seventeen thousand dollars, would enhance the plan and provide an

essential review of the plan elements for the various reviewing

agencies. and

WHEREAS, the involved agencies have agreed to fund this review, with King County's share being determined at two thousand dollars, and

WHEREAS, the study will have substantial benefit to planning for land use and transportation functions, among other benefits,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That the sum of two thousand dollars is hereby recognized to be expended by the Department of Public Works and Transportation for preparing a review and analysis report of the River Basin Coordinating Committee (R.I.B.C.O.) studies recommendations by
