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A MOTION setting the date of hearing on a Final Assessment Roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 61

WHEREAS, on July 29, 1974, the County Council of King County, Washington, passed Ordinance No. 2106 establishing King County Road Improvement District No. 61, and

WHEREAS, the construction of the improvement has now been completed, and the exact cost of the improvement is now known, and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 2106 directed the Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, upon determination of the cost of the improvement, to prepare and file with the Clerk of the King County Council an Assessment Roll for that portion of the entire cost and expense of said improvement to be assessed against the property included within Road Improvement District No. 61, and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has now prepared and filed said Final Assessment Roll with the Clerk of the King County Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090, the hearing upon the Final Assessment Roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 61 shall be scheduled for February 3 1975, at 9:30 a.m.
- The King County Council will sit as a board of equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

3. The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed owners of the property whose name appears thereon by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at the address of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Comptroller; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same with the Clerk of the council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
