WHEREAS, Puget Sound Power and Light Company has made plans to install, maintain and replace electric transmission and/or distribution lines on certain lands to be acquired by King County for Soos Creek Regional Park per Stipulation and Order filed in Superior Court Cause No. 775813 on 26 September 1974, and

WHEREAS, the lands to be acquired through the above-mentioned Stipulation and Order are Puget Sound Power and Light Company lands, acquired by Puget Sound Power and Light Company for electric transmission and/or distribution line purposes, and

WHEREAS, the County has deemed it necessary to acquire such lands from Puget Sound Power and Light Company in accordance with the County development plans for the Soos Creek Regional Park, and

WHEREAS, per the Stipulation and Order entered in Superior Court Cause No. 775813, Puget Sound Power and Light Company has agreed to convey the above-mentioned lands to King County, provided that King County shall grant to Puget Sound Power and Light Company, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement for electric transmission and/or distribution line purposes over, across and through the aforementioned lands, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement be granted in partial consideration for the conveyance of Puget Sound Power and Light Company-owned lands to King County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary electric transmission and/or distribution line easement granting to the Puget Sound Power and Light Company a perpetual easement over, across and through the following described property situtated in King County, Washington:
