

MOTION NO. 1874

1 A MOTION authorizing King County's Housing and  
 2 Community Development activities to be included  
 in the 1975 Block Grant application process.

3 WHEREAS King County's "Urban County" arrangement requires  
 4 that a governing body validate and prioritize all project  
 5 proposals which its jurisdiction desires to undertake with Block  
 6 Grant funds, and

7 WHEREAS King County receives \$543,000 in "population monies"  
 8 for the 1975 program year which it can allocate consistent with  
 9 the King County Community Development Objectives, and

10 WHEREAS, to receive additional Block Grant monies for the  
 11 1975 program year, King County must submit additional project  
 12 proposals to be considered with proposals from other participating  
 13 jurisdictions for funding based on need,

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the King County Council that  
 15 the following projects are to be included in the 1975 action year  
 program to be funded out of the County's "population monies":

 2 included for funding consideration from the unincorporated  
 3 "needs monies":

7	County-wide Housing Rehabilitation Program with emphasis on Snoqualmie Valley, Algonia/Pacific and suburban cities' target areas	100,000

11 Funds for the County-wide Housing Rehabilitation Program  
 12 and the County-wide Housing Repair Program shall not be expended  
 13 until a program has been authorized by the County Council. A  
 14 task force composed of representatives from at least Budget and  
 15 Program Planning, Land Use Management, the Building Department,  
 16 the Prosecutor's Office, the King County Housing Authority,  
 17 suburban jurisdictions, the private sector, and citizens shall  
 18 be formed to advise the staff in the development of the program.
