

A MOTION proclaiming the week beginning
May 1st as Youth Week.

1 WHEREAS, the Benevolent and protective Order of Elks has
2 designated the week beginning May 1st, as Youth Week to honor
3 America's Junior Citizens for their accomplishments, and to give
4 fitting recognition of their services to Community, State and
5 Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, Lake City Elks Lodge #1800 will sponsor an
7 observance during that week in tribute to the Junior Citizens of
8 this Community; and

9 WHEREAS, no event could be more deserving of our support
10 and participation than one dedicated to these young people who
11 represent the nation's greatest resource, and who in the years
12 ahead will assume the responsibility for the advancement of our
13 free society; and

14 WHEREAS, our Youth need the guidance, inspiration and
15 encouragement which we can give in order to develop these
16 qualities of character essential for future leadership; and

17 WHEREAS, to achieve this worth objective we should
18 demonstrate our partnership with Youth, our understanding of their
19 hopes and aspirations and a sincere willingness to help prepare
20 them in every way for the responsibilities and opportunities of
21 citizenship;

22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;

23 The King County Council hereby proclaims the week begin-
24 ning May 1st as Youth Week and urges all departments of
25 government, civic, fraternal and patriotic groups, and citizens
26 generally, to participate wholeheartedly in its observance.
