

MOTION AND RESOLUTION NO. 1900

1 A MOTION AND RESOLUTION finding that an  
2 emergency exists in the funding of the  
3 completion of the King County Multi-  
4 purpose Stadium, estimating the amount  
5 of funds required and setting a date  
6 for hearing on the emergency expenditure  
7 of funds and Proposed Ordinance No. 75-91.

8 WHEREAS, the King County Council passed Motion No. 1887 on  
9 February 18, 1975, which authorized and approved the entering  
10 into of an agreement by the King County Executive with a consor-  
11 tium of Seattle banks to fund the completion costs of the King  
12 County Multi-purpose Stadium, subject to Council approval by  
13 ordinance.

14 WHEREAS, expenditures of such funds was not included in the  
15 1975 budget of said County; and,

16 WHEREAS, it appears that an emergency exists and that the  
17 expenditure of such funds could not have been reasonably foreseen  
18 at the time of making said budget.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED AND RESOLVED by the Council of  
20 King County:

21 Section 1. Appropriation Required. The estimated amount of  
22 funds to meet such emergency is thirteen million five hundred  
23 eighty-four thousand six hundred forty-seven dollars.


24 Section 2. Notice of a Public Hearing. Notice of a public  
25 hearing upon such emergency expenditure proposed by this Motion  
26 and Resolution and Proposed Ordinance No. 75-91, an ordinance  
27 relating to the King County Multi-purpose Stadium; appropriating  
28 an amount not to exceed thirteen million five hundred eighty-four  
29 thousand six hundred forty-seven dollars; creating a King County  
30 Stadium Supplemental Construction Fund; providing for the



1 issuance of warrants on that fund, and the manner of redemption  
2 of warrants on that fund; authorizing, approving, ratifying and  
3 confirming the execution of an agreement between the County and  
4 certain banks, shall be given, said hearing to be held on Monday,  
5 March 17, 1975, at 402 King County Courthouse, at the hour of  
6 9:30 A.M.
