A MOTION authorizing the return of the Mud Mountain Park to the Federal Government

WHEREAS, King County received from the Federal Government on June 18, 1962, a park known as Mud Mountain Park, under the provisions of the Federal Property and Administration Services Act of 1949, as amended; and

WHEREAS, King County agreed to develop subject property for public recreational use within a reasonable period of time; and

WHEREAS, problems of obtaining safe public access and budget constraints have precluded the County from developing the necessary recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that it is no longer appropriate and suitable for King County to own and manage this park property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized and directed to notify the Federal Government that King County is voluntarily returning the Mud Mountain Park property and to take what action is necessary to conclude such transfer to the Federal Government.
