A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a Grant Application to the Department of Social & Health Services for funds in the amount of \$750,000 to enable the Division of Alcoholism Services to plan and construct a Long Term-Advanced Chronic Alcoholism Residential Care Facility

WHEREAS, The State of Washington, through Referendum 29, provides for the award of grants by the Department of Social & Health Services to be used for the planning and construction of social and health service facilities, and

WHEREAS, The County's Comprehensive Alcoholism Plan recognizes as a goal the need for a Long Term-Advanced Chronic Alcoholism Residential Care Facility, and

WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide approximately \$250,000 in a cash match in support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

- The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$750,000 to the Department of Social & Health Services on behalf of King County;
- The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- The Intergovernmental Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
