MOTION NO. 1923

A MOTION declaring the intention to form a Road Improvement District to improve the streets in the plat of St. Francis Wood.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District to improve the streets in the plat of St. Francis Wood;

WHEREAS, the petitioners request that payments for the improvement be made by special assessment payable in fifteen (15) equal annual installments, under mode of payment by bond; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on November 30, 1973, referred the above petition to the Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of 76 percent of the lineal frontage upon the improvement to be made, and by owners of 85 percent of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created; and

WHEREAS, the improvement appears to be feasible and the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.010, 36.88.020, and 36.88.050, it is the intention of the King County Council to order the improvement of the streets in the plat of St. Francis Wood. SE 42nd Place and the unvacated portion of SE 43rd Street in the plat of St. Francis Wood will be improved by clearing, grubbing, grading, draining, ballasting, and paving with asphaltic concrete, and such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith; all in accordance with plans prepared by the property owners' consulting engineer.
- 2. The estimated cost and expense of said improvement is hereby declared to be \$50,674.18. As requested by the petitions, it is the intention of the King County Council to assess property
