WHEREAS, on May 14, 1951, King County and the Housing

Agreement which enabled the Housing Authority to acquire a war

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of King has applied for \$2,158,126.00 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for Phase I of a modernization program for Park Lake Homes, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development requires that King County reaffirm its Cooperation Agreement with the Housing Authority before the Department will make available the \$2,158,126.00 for modernization of Park Lake Homes,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Cooperation Agreement between King County and the Housing Authority of the County of King, dated May 14, 1951, relating to a project formerly known as White Center Heights and now known as Park Lake Homes is hereby reaffirmed by King County.
