1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
2 execute and submit a grant application to the  
3 Law Enforcement Assistance Administration for  
4 funds in the amount of \$44,000 to enable the  
5 King County Department of Public Safety to  
6 commence the design and development of an  
7 improved management reporting capability within  
8 the Department, King County File No. 533.

9 WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of  
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law  
11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,  
12 through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to improve  
14 the management reporting capability within the Department of  
15 Public Safety, and

16 WHEREAS, The County Council finds that an improved management  
17 reporting capability is in the best interest of the general  
18 public, and

19 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide  
20 approximately \$4,890 in a cash match for support of this project,

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

22 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
23 application for funds in the amount of \$44,000 to the State Law  
24 and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

25 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed  
26 to file and execute such application and contracts as are required  
27 by the State;

28 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the  
29 authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized  
30 to furnish such additional information and documents as may be  
31 required by the State;

32 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into  
and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implemen-  
tation of the project.
