

MOTION NO. 1977

1 A MOTION directing completion of the final  
2 environmental impact statement for the  
3 proposed King County Shoreline Management  
4 Master Program and directing the submission  
5 of the proposed Program to the Washington  
6 State Department of Ecology for certification.

7 WHEREAS, the Shoreline Management Act of 1971 directed that  
8 local governments develop a Master Program consistent with the  
9 policy and guidelines enunciated in the Act (RCW 90.58) and the  
10 Department of Ecology Final Guidelines (WAC 173-16); and

11 WHEREAS, the Master Program attached hereto has been and is  
12 being developed in a manner consistent with the Shoreline  
13 Management Act, the Department of Ecology Final Guidelines and  
14 the State Environmental Policy Act, through the utilization of  
15 County departments, other public agencies, a Citizens Advisory  
16 Committee, the Policy Development Commission, other members of  
17 the public and all available and relevant plans, studies, surveys  
18 and inventories; and

19 WHEREAS, numerous public meetings and hearings on this  
20 Master Program have been held after proper public notice given.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 1. The Department of Budget and Program Planning is hereby  
23 directed to complete the environmental impact statement for the  
24 proposed Master Program by:

25 (a) expanding the present draft statement to address the  
26 Master Program in its present form, as amended by the King County  
27 Council as of May 12, 1975.

28 (b) recirculate the revised draft statement;

29 (c) comments from entities to whom the draft is circulated  
30 shall be reviewed by the Committee on Planning and Community  
31 Development;

1 (d) prepare the final impact statement.

2 2. The final impact statement and proposed Master Program  
3 are hereby directed to be submitted to the Washington State  
4 Department of Ecology for their review and certification.


5 3. Before adoption of a Program by ordinance, the King  
6 County Council shall further consider the proposed Master  
7 Program, together with the final environmental impact statement,  
8 at a subsequent public hearing.
