2 A MOTION declaring the intention to form a
3 Road Improvement District for underground
wiring in No-Ko-Mis Park, near Seahurst.

4 WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County
5 Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District
6 for the conversion of existing overhead wiring to underground
7 wiring and the erection of ornamental street lights in the streets
8 of a portion of the plat of No-Ko-Mis Park. The petition
9 stipulated an estimated assessment of \$950 per buildable site and
10 requested that the payments for this improvement be made by
11 special assessment payable in fifteen equal annual installments.

12 WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on February 10,
13 1975, referred the above said petition to the Director, Department
14 of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommenda-
15 tion, and

16 WHEREAS, said Director has contacted Seattle City Light and
17 Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company, and they have estab-
18 lished a boundary that is feasible for the improvement district,
19 and

20 WHEREAS, said Director also contacted TelePrompeter of
21 Seattle CATV, and was informed that all property owners are on
22 CATV and that a CATV cost of \$65 should be added to the \$950 per
23 buildable site cost, and

24 WHEREAS, the Director, Department of Public Works and Trans-
25 portation, has certified that said petition has been signed by
26 owners of 64 percent of the lineal front footage upon the
27 proposed improvement and 51 per cent of the area within the
28 boundary of the proposed improvement district,

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

30 1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.020,
31 36.88.050, and 36.88.410, it is the intention of the County
32 Council of King County, Washington, to order the improvement of
