A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration in the amount of \$328,020 and to the Washington State Aeronautics Commission in the amount of \$48,990 to support the Airport Land Acquisition Project.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration and Washington State Aeronautics Commission is empowered to make grant awards for the construction and improvement of public airports, and

WHEREAS, the King County International Airport upon receipt of grant approval will purchase approximately 3.267 acres of adjacent land for aviation related purposes, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes it's obligation to provide approximately \$48,990 as cash match in support of this project, and

WHEREAS, funds will not be transferred until the Airport is in receipt of notification of approval for said grants, and

1 WHEREAS, King County has the first right of refusal for
2 said property until May 15, 1975.

3 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
4 County:

5 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to
6 make application for funds in the amount of \$328,020 to the U.S.
7 Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration
8 and to the Washington State Aeronautics Commission in the amount
9 of \$48,990 on behalf of King County.

10 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and
11 directed to file and execute such applications and contracts
12 as required by the Federal Aviation Administration and Washington
13 State Aeronautics Commission.

14 3. The King County Executive upon receipt of sufficient
15 grant funds is authorized to acquire said property.

16 4. The Federal/State Relations Division is named
17 the authorized correspondent for King County and is authorized
18 to furnish such additional information and documents as may be
19 required by the Federal Aviation Administration and Washington
20 State Aeronautics Commission.

21 5. The United States of America, Department of
22 Transportation, is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI
23 of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
