

A MOTION relating to the approval of the sale of King County Fee Simple Property.

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WHEREAS, King County is the owner in fee simple of certain lands and buildings described as:

All of Block 37, Bigelow's Addition to Seattle and,

WHEREAS, preliminary investigation reveals that the sale of the aforementioned lands and buildings would be advantageous to the citizens of King County and,

WHEREAS, the King County Council deems it necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County to surplus and sell said lands and buildings according to the procedure established by law for the sale of such property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


