MOTION NO. 2075

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to accept a grant of \$18,000 for facility planning for Cedar Hills Landfill Interceptor System.

WHEREAS, the Water Pollution Control Laws of the State of Washington (RCW 90.48) provide for grants for the construction of publicly owned waste water treatment works as defined under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act as amended, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, has responsibility for the environmentally safe disposal of Solid Waste at King County disposal facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Hills Landfill facility has been cited for violation of Chapter 90.48.080 RCW for pollution of Mason and Issaquah Creeks, and

WHEREAS, King County has a statutory responsibility for taking immediate and positive action toward eliminating the source of said pollution, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology and United States Environmental Protection Agency have offered Step 1 grants of \$3,000 and \$15,000 respectively,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to accept and execute such grants.
2. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
