A MOTION extending the time period of Special Permit No. 200-72-ZA for a period of ninety (90) days, authorizing the removal of stockpiled materials from certain property owned by the Weyerhaeuser Company.

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, the King County Council by Ordinance No. 1280 granted a special permit petitioned by the Weyerhaeuser Company for the extraction and processing of natural materials, Land Use Management File No. 200-72-ZA; and

WHEREAS, the time period of said permit is from July 13, 1972 to July 13, 1975; and

WHEREAS, the Weyerhaeuser Company has requested a nunety (90) day extension of said permit in order to remove materials stockpiled on the property and to complete a contract with the State Highway Department which was the purpose of the original application; and

WHEREAS, the King County Divison of Building has reported that the permit has been exercised in compliance with all conditions of Ordinance No. 1280, and that removal of the stockpiled materials would contribute to the reclamation of the subject property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The time period of Special Permit No. 200-72-ZA, issued to the Weyerhaeuser Company by Ordinance No. 1280, is extended to October 13, 1975 for the specific purpose of authorizing the removal of materials stockpiled on the subject property.
