2 A MOTION extending the time period of Special  
3 Permit No. 200-72-ZA for a period of ninety (90)  
4 days, authorizing the removal of stockpiled  
5 materials from certain property owned by the  
6 Weyerhaeuser Company.

7 WHEREAS, the King County Council by Ordinance No. 1280  
8 granted a special permit petitioned by the Weyerhaeuser  
9 Company for the extraction and processing of natural materials,  
10 Land Use Management File No. 200-72-ZA; and

11 WHEREAS, the time period of said permit is from July 13,  
12 1972 to July 13, 1975; and

13 WHEREAS, the Weyerhaeuser Company has requested a  
14 ninety (90) day extension of said permit in order to remove  
15 materials stockpiled on the property and to complete a  
16 contract with the State Highway Department which was the  
17 purpose of the original application; and

18 WHEREAS, the King County Divison of Building has reported  
19 that the permit has been exercised in compliance with all  
20 conditions of Ordinance No. 1280, and that removal of the  
21 stockpiled materials would contribute to the reclamation of  
22 the subject property;

23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:  
24 The time period of Special Permit No. 200-72-ZA, issued to the  
25 Weyerhaeuser Company by Ordinance No. 1280, is extended to  
26 October 13, 1975 for the specific purpose of authorizing the  
27 removal of materials stockpiled on the subject property.
