

MOTION NO. 2095

A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner regarding the application for a reclassification petitioned by FEDERAL WAY DISPOSAL CO., designated File No. 237-75-R and adding conditions thereto.

WHEREAS the Council has reviewed the written recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner attached hereto regarding the reclassification petitioned by FEDERAL WAY DISPOSAL CO., designated Land Use Management File No. 237-75-R; and

WHEREAS the Council finds that a more definite statement of Council intent is needed under the "P-suffix" designation,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The Council concurs with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, dated July 15, 1975, with the following conditions:

1. Approval of a landscape plan by the Division of Land Use Management. Plans shall contain landscaping along the north and east property lines.
2. The posting of a \$1,000 landscape bond to insure installation and maintenance of landscaping on the subject property.
