2 A MOTION requesting the Policy Development
3 Commission to consider the three proposals for
4 the Alpine Lakes Area and recommend policy
5 to guide future County management actions for
6 these and other wilderness recreation areas
7 of King County.

8 WHEREAS, King County recognizes the unique and limited
9 natural resources of the Alpine Lakes region and other similar
10 wilderness areas, and

11 WHEREAS, King County has adopted policies through the
12 Shoreline Management Master Program which classify the shorelines
13 of the Alpine Lakes Region as Natural Environments to ensure the
14 protection and preservation of the natural amenities of the
15 area's shorelines, and

16 WHEREAS, the wilderness land areas of the Central Cascades
17 region of King County have been classified as a Forest-Recreation
18 Zone in the King County Zoning Code, and

19 WHEREAS, the management of the County's wilderness areas is
20 challenged by mixed public and private ownership patterns, and

21 WHEREAS, seventy-five percent of the land in the Alpine
22 Lakes region of the Central Cascades is publicly owned, and

23 WHEREAS, King County government has an ultimate and
24 continuing role in land use management in all areas of the County,

25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 That the Policy Development Commission is requested to
27 consider the three proposals for the Alpine Lakes Area and to
28 recommend policy to guide future County management actions for
29 these and other wilderness recreation areas of King County.
