

MOTION NO. 2100

A MOTION relating to King County participation in the American Revolution Bicentennial Celebration.

WHEREAS, the United States will celebrate the bicentennial of the American Revolution in 1976, and

WHEREAS, the Council has included in its priorities for the 1976 operating budget that provision should be made for bicentennial projects, and

WHEREAS, the nature of King County's bicentennial projects should be jointly developed between the Executive and Legislative branches of government, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle/King County American Revolution Bicentennial Commission has developed a plan to enhance the celebration of the bicentennial,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Executive is requested to prepare an ordinance appropriating a sum not to exceed an additional \$25,000 from all sources, to support the plan of the Seattle/King County American Revolution Bicentennial Commission to celebrate the nation's anniversary.

1           There is hereby formed the King County Government  
2 Bicentennial Project Coordinating Committee consisting of a  
3 representative of the County Council to be appointed by the  
4 Chairman of the Council, a representative of the King County  
5 Arts Commission to be appointed by its Chairman, a representative  
6 of the Policy Development Commission to be appointed by its  
7 Chairman and a representative to be appointed by the County  
8 Executive to work with the Seattle/King County American Revolution  
9 Bicentennial Commission and County Departments to develop County  
10 bicentennial projects and programs.
