

A MOTION granting an easement in favor of Puget Sound Power and Light Company, over Lakota Park.

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Power & Light Company, a Washington Corporation, has made application for the right to construct and maintain an overhead power line over a tract of land which is a portion of Lakota Park, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the County's advantage to grant the easement described herein, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement be granted,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED, by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary overhang easement, granting to Puget Sound Power & Light Company the easement described as follows:

In that portion of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 12, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M., lying northeasterly of County Road #980 and northwesterly of Robert Malty Road and South of S.W. 312th Street;

A Right of Way ten (10) feet in width having five (5) feet of such width on each side of a centerline described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southerly margin of S.W. 312th Street approximately 40 feet westerly from the Northeast corner of the above described property; thence Southwesterly 60 feet more or less, to a point on the northeasterly margin of County Road #980 approximately 15 feet Northwesterly from the most southerly corner thereof and the terminus of said centerline.

The consideration for the granting of the easement shall be \$110.00.
