MOTION NO.

A MOTION setting forth criteria for approval of, and standard conditions for administering current use taxation requests for timber lands of five to twenty acres in size.

WHEREAS, the State Open Space Taxation Act (RCW 84.34) as amended provides for the inclusion of timber lands of five acres or more in the County's current use assessment program as open space land subject to Council action after a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, state law relating to current use taxation of open space lands authorizes the local legislative authority to determine the qualification of nonfarm open space applications for current use taxation by weighing the benefits to the general welfare of preserving the current use of the property against the potential loss in revenue which may result from granting the application; and

WHEREAS, the costs in legislation and administrative time are significant and continue to rise; and

WHEREAS, in response to the above factors the Open Space program of King County has been substantially modified and restricted by County Ordinance No. 2250; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to make current use assessment available to owners of strategic smaller parcels of timber land which do not qualify under other timber taxation programs because of parcel size, and do not meet the criteria set forth in Ordinance 2250.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- (1) The following criteria be established as a basis for Council approval of current use taxation requests for timber parcels between five and twenty acres:
- (a) The request must include at least five acres of timber land;
- (b) The property must lie within an established FR (Forestry Recreation) or A (Agricultural) zone.

1	(2) The following standard conditions of approval be
2	applied to all such properties granted current use taxation:
3	(a) The property to be classified shall not include any
4	improvements other than improvements devoted to the production of
,5	timber.
6	(b) The property shall be managed in accordance with a
7	forest management plan, primarily for the production of
8	commercial timber species.
9	(c) The property shall comply with the restocking, forest
10	management, fire protection, insect and disease control, and
11	forest debris provisions of Title 76 RCW or any applicable
12	regulations thereunder.
13	(d) The property may be used for other compatible
14	recreational and/or educational purposes so long as these uses do
15	not interfere or conflict with the aforementioned mandatory
16	criteria.
17	(3) A new ordinance be drawn for approval of current use
18	taxation requests for timber parcels between five and twenty
19	acres based on the criteria outlined in (1) above.
