A MOTION authorizing the Executive to execute the Housing Repair Program with funding from the Community Development Block Grant.

WHEREAS, in Motion 1874 the King County Council authorized the use of 1975 Block Grant Funds to repair and rehabilitate housing for low and moderate income families, and

WHEREAS, the Council withheld authorization to spend funds until a specific program had been developed and reviewed by the Council, and

WHEREAS, a Task Force was to be created to advise the Executive in the development of this program, and

WHEREAS, a Housing Repair Program has now been developed satisfying the Council conditions and having the support of the Task Force.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Executive is authorized to execute the Housing Repair Program for low and moderate income families using Community Development Block Grant Funds, provided that costs of administering the program do not exceed \$22,873. Provided further that if one secretarial position funded by the Comprehensive Employment Training Act be allocated to the County Housing Authority of King County for this program then the administrative costs would not exceed \$19,900.
