 MOTION NO.

A MOTION supporting the effort of the King County Executive to reach an agreement in 1976 with the City of Seattle concerning the administrative structure and financing of the Department of Public Health.

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes the programmatic and administrative difficulties posed by the present joint operation of the Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that the welfare of King County citizens is potentially best served by means of a County-wide Health Department under County administration; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has entered into discussions with officials of the City of Seattle concerning this matter pursuant to Council intent;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That the County Council supports the efforts of the County Executive to seek an agreement with the City of Seattle leading to the establishment of a County-wide, jointly funded Health Department under County administration.

That the intent would be that such an agreement or some form of administration of the County's health care responsibilities other than the present form shall become effective on or about January 1, 1977.

That a task force composed of staff from the Council, the Department of Executive Administration, and the Department of Budget and Program Development be formed to work towards an equitable County-wide program for the provision of health services. The task force shall make its recommendations to the Council no later than June 1, 1976.
