A MOTION establishing an exchange policy between county employees and other government agencies and private industry.

WHEREAS, King County must cooperate with hundreds of private firms, public agencies and individuals every day of the year, and

WHEREAS, decisions made by the county affect the future of these firms, agencies and individuals in profound and often unforeseen ways, and

WHEREAS, often the impact of these decisions is neither understood nor appreciated by the county employee responsible for the decision, and

WHEREAS, a most effective way to become sensitive to the needs and interests of those requesting action by the county is through practical work experience,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The Council Administrator is hereby directed to propose an exchange program for council staff employees between the county, other governmental agencies and private industry. To the fullest extent the program established should provide the opportunities for both staff of the council and staff of other government agencies and private firms to gain comparable on the job experience.

2. The County Executive is requested to develop a similar exchange program for all appropriate and eligible county employees.
