A MOTION relating to the adoption of an interim policy regarding agricultural lands located in the area of unincorporated King County west of and including Range 5.

WHEREAS, King County adopted Ordinance 1096 on January 10, 1972, which established a farmlands policy for all agricultural lands in King County and which states: "Class II and III soils having agricultural potential and other classified or unclassified land presently being farmed shall be reserved for current and anticipated needs", and

WHEREAS, King County adopted Ordinance 1839 on November 3, 1973, which established policy regarding agricultural lands of unincorporated King County located only in the area East of and including Range 6 and which states: "All individual parcels of agricultural land having Class II and/or Class III soils that collectively comprise a contiguous area of 160 or more acres" shall be included in open space uses, and

WHEREAS, the County policy regarding agricultural lands located in the area of King County West of and including Range 5 is not clearly defined at the present time, and

WHEREAS, a study which will result in proposals for policies and/or programs regarding agricultural lands located West of and including Range 5 has been proposed and will be completed on or before December 31, 1976.

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish an interim policy to guide zoning or other land use decisions which may come before the King County Council prior to the completion of the above cited study,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. Lands located in unincorporated King County West of and including Range 5 which meet each of the following criteria shall not be reclassified:
  - a. Lands classified for agricultural use under K.C.C. 21.22

 b. Lands containing Class II or Class III soils

c. Land which have been used for commercial agricultural production during 1975.

This policy shall not be effective after December 31,
1976.
