A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Environmental Protection Agency for funds in the amount of \$34,600 to support Black Diamond Interceptor Sewer Project, Step 1, Facilities Planning, County File No. 559.

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency is empowered by Public Law 92-500, Section 201, to make grant awards for the purposes of Water Quality Control, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Black Diamond and Water District 86 (Lake Sawyer) have a need for a Facilities Planning Study and have agreed that King County will manage the study on their behalf, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide approximately \$4,600 as an in-kind share in support of this project, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Department of Ecology, is expected to provide approximately \$6,900 as a cash contribution in support of this project,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$34,600 to the Environmental Protection Agency on behalf of King County;
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Environmental Protection Agency;
- 3. The United States of America is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
