MOTION NO. 2298

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to implement salary adjustments agreed to by the County negotiating team and certain labor organizations and authorizing the County Executive to implement a salary adjustment for County employees not represented by labor organizations effective January 1, 1976.

WHEREAS, the County negotiating team has reached agreement with certain labor organizations representing County employees for 1976, and

WHEREAS, these agreements were reached in a time frame which would give the County Council inadequate time for proper review prior to ratification, and

WHEREAS, the County negotiating team expects to reach agreement with other labor organizations representing County employees for 1976, and

WHEREAS, non-represented employees have received no cost-of-living increase since January 1, 1975.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED that the Council of King County hereby authorizes and directs the County Executive to implement salary adjustments effective January 1, 1976, that have been agreed to and those that become agreed to with the proviso that agreements reached with these groups remain subject to Council review and ratification; and to similarly implement a salary adjustment to non-represented County employees. The County Executive will forward signed copies of the agreements and the 1976 Salary Ordinance to the County Council as soon as is possible.
