MOTION NO. 2300

A MOTION requesting the Washington State Legislature to amend statutory provisions pertaining to the State retirement programs to prohibit certain activities by public employees; requesting that the Executive perform certain activities.

WHEREAS, there is a practice called the "double dip" by which a public employee can retire from any state retirement system and continue to collect retirement benefits from one program while working as an active public employee in a position covered by the other retirement system, and

WHEREAS, King County has a vested interest in state
retirement programs by virtue of the substantial fiscal commitment
of public funds, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Council that the practice of the "double dip" is not in the public's interest, and

WHEREAS, state retirement programs contain statutory provisions that require the payment of retirement benefits to be suspended should a retired employee resume public employment in a position covered by the retirement program from which they have previously retired, and

WHEREAS, without state legislative action, King County cannot enact comprehensive and equitable policies affecting all county employees resulting in the prohibition of the so called "double dip",

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council requests that the Washington State Legislature enact implementing legislation to prohibit the so called practice of the "double dip" by public employees participation in the state retirement programs;

PROVIDED FURTHER, the Executive is requested, following action by the State Legislature and in accordance with Article 5

1	of the Home Rule Charter, to submit an ordinance prohibiting
2	the so called "double dip" as a condition for future employment
3	with the county.
