1 A MOTION granting the City of Seattle an easement for
2 a watermain within the Lake Washington - Seattle North
Trail in King County.

3 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle, a municipal corporation duly organized and
4 existing under the laws of the State of Washington, has made application for
5 the right to construct and maintain a watermain with appurtenant hydrants and
6 connections within the hereinafter described property of King County, and

7 WHEREAS, investigation reveals the watermain would benefit the citizens
8 of King County residing in the vicinity of the proposed route, and

9 WHEREAS, it is determined that it would be to the County's advantage and
10 in the best interests of the citizens of King County and the City of Seattle
11 that the said easement be granted, for and in consideration of mutual
12 benefits.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


14 The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary
15 agreement granting the City of Seattle the easement over, under, across and
16 along the following described property situated in King County, State of
17 Washington:

18 A strip of land 6 feet in width with a centerline two (2) feet
19 westerly of and parallel to the centerline of the trail right of
20 way existing in that portion of the Lake Washington - Seattle
North Trail (Burke-Gilman Trail) lying between N.E. 145th Street
and N.E. 160th Street, as acquired by the County from Burlington
Northern, Inc. on June 1, 1974, under recording No. 7406100492.


21 Together with eight (8) areas ten (10) feet wide extending three
22 (3) feet beyond the center point of the water hydrants to be
23 installed as approved by the County and in locations approved by
the County.
