## MOTION NO. 2314

A MOTION recognizing the 1975 King County General Bicycle Plan as a technical document for the planning and development of a bicycle system as an integral part of the non-motorized element of the King County Interim Transportation Plan: Focus 1990, and to be utilized as an interim bicycle element of the Comprehensive Plan until such time as it is updated and adopted.

WHEREAS, the 1964 Comprehensive Plan for King County, page viii contained the following statement, "Some additional detailed studies concerned with individual elements of the plan have been prepared, and it is anticipated that others will follow. Such studies provide working material in greater detail than that contained within (the) Comprehensive Plan... As such, they are supplementary to the plan itself and may be subject to revision as conditions warrant in conformance with the statement contained herein;" and

WHEREAS, the 1974 King County Interim Transportation Plan has been recognized by King County Council Motion No. 1744 (September 9, 1974) as an update and expansion of the 1967 Major Streets and Highways Plan, and

WHEREAS, in addition to including the streets and highway element of transportation, the Interim Transportation Plan also addresses the non-motorized element of transportation, including the bicycle, and

WHEREAS, King County Council Motion No. 1724 (Aug. 19, 1974) directed the preparation and documentation of a plan for bicycle activity in King County, and

WHEREAS, since 1971 numerous changes have taken place which have underscored the need to document the 1975 King County General Bicycle Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

(1) The 1975 King County General Bicycle Plan be recognized as a refinement of the King County Interim Transportation Plan: Focus 1990 and be utilized as the basic technical document for

bicycle planning until the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan is updated and adopted.

(2) As a technical document, the General Bicycle Plan is to provide a basis for a coordinated look at bicycle facility development within King County towards the goal of a diversified and integrated system of bicycle networks.
