A MOTION relating to the 1976 Mental Health Plan of King County; modifying the plan; increasing the fiscal allocation to the Seattle Counseling Service.

WHEREAS, W.A.C. regulation 275-12-136 specifies that an agency has the right to appeal to the King County Council when it is dissatisfied with a funding decision made by the King County Mental Health Administrative Board, and

WHEREAS, Seattle Counseling Service for Sexual Minorities has appealed the decision of the Mental Health Board with regard to the agency's funding for 1975 and 1976, and

WHEREAS, the Council's Health and Human Service Committee held a prolonged public hearing beginning January 28, 1976, which was concluded February 10, 1976

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: Council staff is directed to insure that the 1976 Mental Health Plan of King County reflect a deduction of \$6,805.00 from the present proposed contingency fund and that a similar amount be clearly reflected as an allocation for contracted service with the Seattle Counseling Service program; PROVIDED THAT, the Council clearly recognizes that should contingencies arise in the County's Mental Health program, it shall make every effort to replace deducted monies to the contingency fund.
