76 - 96MOTION NO. 2319

A MOTION authorizing the King County Council to recommend and introduce in the Washington State Legislature enabling legislation to authorize the use of school buses for transporting patrons to and from the King County Stadium for events of maximum use.

WHEREAS, King County has contracted the King Dome Stadium and it is their desire to see that it is utilized to the fullest extent possible; and

WHEREAS, it is projected by the King County Department of Stadium Administration, based upon the studies of stadium usage, that there will be capacity crowds from 55,000 to 67,000 persons approximately 18 times a year; and

WHEREAS, the projected parking for both Metro transit and private automobiles will necessitate many of the patrons of those big events walking as far as a mile and a quarter to attend said events; and

WHEREAS, all of the projections for the stadium usage on these maximum events indicate that there will be extreme traffic congestion on the freeway and other routes servicing that facility; and

WHEREAS, there is not enough parking on the stadium site to facilitate those who intend to attend the functions on those days of maximum use; and

WHEREAS, there is a source of transportation, namely, school buses, that could relieve the congestion and could handle all or any part of those desiring to attend stadium functions, and could be parked on the stadium site - all at a lesser cost than the use of private automobiles or even Metro coaches; and

WHEREAS, there are constraints placed upon the use of school bus facilities by State law, and it being desirable

that said school bus facilities be made available to relieve the traffic congestion at the King County Stadium.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the King County Council that enabling legislation be introduced by the King County Council in the Washington State Legislature to permit the use of school buses to relieve the conjestion at times of maximum use of the King Dome facility.
