

MOTION NO. 2320

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a Proposal to the Washington State Department of Health and Social Services for funds in the amount of \$153,000 to provide transitional care treatment services in King County.

WHEREAS, there has been identified by the King County Mental Health Board an unmet need for transitional care treatment for those persons being placed into King County from State mental institutions, and

WHEREAS, the State has set aside funds to specifically address the immediate transitional care treatment needs in King County and has worked with the King County Mental Health Board in the development of the Transitional Care Treatment Proposal, and

WHEREAS, the implementation of this proposal would have greater benefit to the citizens of King County than the current use of available transitional care treatment funds, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of King County to continue such program if approved by the State as long as State funds are available for such purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$153,000 to the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Bureau of Mental Health on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Bureau of Mental Health;


3. The State of Washington is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
