

MOTION 2350

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A MOTION denying the appeal of the applicant in the matter of the reclassification request of F<sup>2</sup>, Inc., Building and Land Development File No. 136-75-R and stating Council intent in maintaining the existing G (General) classification of the property.

WHEREAS, the subject reclassification request was recommended for denial by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner and such recommendation has been appealed by the applicant; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Community Development Committee has reviewed the record on the above matter; and

WHEREAS, the reclassification request and the appeal were based on a decision by the Seattle-King County Health Department to require the property to be served by sewers; and


WHEREAS, a representative of the Seattle-King County Health Department has advised the Planning and Community Development Committee at the appeal hearing that they will now consider the previously submitted Preliminary Plat of Hollywood Terrace (Building and Land Development File No. 475-3) on the basis of septic tanks as a sewage disposal system,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The request of F<sup>2</sup>, Inc., designated Building and Land Development File No. 136-75-R, for reclassification of the subject property from G (General) to RS-15,000 is denied.
