A MOTION endorsing the efforts of the Home Rule Committee of the community of Federal Way; requesting that the Executive assist the committee in seeking necessary funds to prepare a feasibility study dealing with alternative forms of government for the Federal Way Community.

WHEREAS, the unincorporated community of Federal Way contains approximately 55,000 people within a generally defined forty square mile area: and

WHEREAS, the community of Federal Way is a metropolitan urban area subject to the same socioeconomic problems of other defined communities in attempting to insure that community development reflects the values of the community in protecting their perception of the community's quality of life; and

WHEREAS, numerous citizens of Federal Way, concerned with the community's future development, have joined together in a group referred to as the Home Rule Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Way Home Rule Committee has been established to study administrative and governmental alternatives for how the community should relate to the citizens of Federal Way, the county, and the region, and

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Committee is attempting to secure funds to perform a feasibility study dealing with public attitudes and alternative forms of government for the positive future development of the Federal Way Community; and

WHEREAS, the county has the expertise and staff to assist the Home Rule Committee in securing funds to perform the proposed feasibility study,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council endorses the efforts of the Federal Way Home Rule Committee in their attempts to conduct a feasibility study of administrative and governmental alternatives aimed at achieving the positive growth of the Federal Way community; and, the Council requests that the Executive assist the members of the Home Rule Committee in securing funds from the proceeds of an appropriate grant to enable the committee to conduct the proposed feasibility study.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED that, upon receipt of the approval of such a grant, the Council requests the Executive to send to the Council a legislative proposal to provide funding necessary to conduct said feasibility study.
