

## MOTION NO. 2357

1 A MOTION endorsing the efforts of the Home  
2 Rule Committee of the community of Federal  
3 Way; requesting that the Executive assist  
4 the committee in seeking necessary funds  
5 to prepare a feasibility study dealing with  
6 alternative forms of government for the  
7 Federal Way Community.

8 WHEREAS, the unincorporated community of Federal Way contains  
9 approximately 55,000 people within a generally defined forty  
10 square mile area; and

11 WHEREAS, the community of Federal Way is a metropolitan urban  
12 area subject to the same socioeconomic problems of other defined  
13 communities in attempting to insure that community development  
14 reflects the values of the community in protecting their per-  
15 ception of the community's quality of life; and

16 WHEREAS, numerous citizens of Federal Way, concerned with the  
17 community's future development, have joined together in a group  
18 referred to as the Home Rule Committee; and

19 WHEREAS, the Federal Way Home Rule Committee has been  
20 established to study administrative and governmental alternatives  
21 for how the community should relate to the citizens of Federal  
22 Way, the county, and the region, and

23 WHEREAS, the Home Rule Committee is attempting to secure  
24 funds to perform a feasibility study dealing with public attitudes  
25 and alternative forms of government for the positive future  
26 development of the Federal Way Community; and

27 WHEREAS, the county has the expertise and staff to assist  
28 the Home Rule Committee in securing funds to perform the proposed  
29 feasibility study,

30 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

31 The Council endorses the efforts of the Federal Way Home  
32 Rule Committee in their attempts to conduct a feasibility study  
33 of administrative and governmental alternatives aimed at achieving  
the positive growth of the Federal Way community; and, the  
Council requests that the Executive assist the members of the



Home Rule Committee in securing funds from the proceeds of an appropriate grant to enable the committee to conduct the proposed feasibility study.


