2 A MOTION relating to a prohibition against
3 adding staff to the Division of Human
4 Services.

5 WHEREAS, the King County Council has raised questions
6 concerning the organizational relationships among the Division of
7 Human Services, the Department of Budget and Program Development,
8 and the King County Administrative Boards, and

9 WHEREAS, the County Executive has established a committee to
10 make recommendations on this organizational question, and

11 WHEREAS, it does not appear to be sound public policy to
12 hire staff for the Division until the Executive's recommendations
13 have been received, except for those positions absolutely
14 necessary to the functioning of the Division and those positions
15 which will aid the Executive in making his recommendations, and

16 WHEREAS, the position of coordinator for the King County
17 Mental Health Administrative Board appears to be necessary to the
18 functioning of the Division, and

19 WHEREAS, it appears that three positions related to
20 implementation of the Division's manual monitoring system will
21 aid the Executive in making his recommendations;


22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 No new positions shall be established nor existing vacant
24 positions filled within the Division of Human Services until the
25 County Executive's recommendations on the organizational
26 structure for providing human services in King County has been
27 approved by the County Council. The only exceptions to this


1 prohibition shall be one coordinator for the King County Mental
2 Health Administrative Board, one monitoring and evaluation
