KEEP AMERICA BEAUTIFUL '76 DAY in King
County,

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Department of Ecology, is
sponsoring litter cleanup campaigns throughout the State together
with the Committee for Keep America Beautiful '76, and

WHEREAS, the Committee is planning for one of the most inten-
sive large scale litter removal campaigns ever conducted in King
County, and the State of Washington for April 24, 1976, and

WHEREAS, over 50,000 citizen volunteers are expected to
participate in the Keep America Beautiful '76 campaign, together
with numerous civic and citizens groups in King County, and

WHEREAS, the goal of the campaign is to remove litter from the
places where the people of King County live, work and play thus
making our county a bit more liveable for all.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
