A MOTION stating the County Council's intention to study the County's Block Grant program and directing the Council Administrator to make a report to the Council on the status of the program by April 16, 1976.

WHEREAS, King County is about to submit its second application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council is not satisfied with the process by which the County develops its application and therefore is not satisfied with the resulting Block Grant program, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council feels that remedial action must be taken and wishes to make its own study of the program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council Administrator is hereby directed to report by April 16, 1976, to the King County Council sitting as the Committee-of-the-Whole as to the status of the County's Block Grant program. The report should include a discussion of and recommendations, where appropriate, on the following aspects of the program:

- 1. The geographic distribution of funds throughout the County.
- 2. The kinds of projects appropriate for Block Grant funding.
- The kinds of projects which are being funded through the Discretionary fund.
 - 4. The role of the County Council in the process.
 - 5. The general policy direction of the program.
 - 6. The role of community input in the process.
