MOTION NO. **2372**

A MOTION urging the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium to take certain actions relative to sustaining employment levels under the Public Employment Program (CETA Titles II & VI).

WHEREAS, King County government administers a public employment program employing over 1000 individuals in suburban cities, school districts, county government, fire districts and nonprofit agencies; and

WHEREAS, the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium has adopted a policy of maintaining this employment level, particularly in the face of increasing unemployment in the King-Snohomish area; and

WHEREAS, to maintain this employment level from April 1 to June 30 will require additional funds, beyond funds currently available to King County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The King County Council urges the KSMC Executive Board on
Monday, March 15 to take action pressing Congress to introduce
and pass an urgent supplemental appropriation providing adequate
funds to maintain employment levels through June 1976; and

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

The King County Council urges the KSMC Executive Board to investigate alternative sources of funds, as a contingency in the advent that additional federal funds are not made available or not made available in a timely manner; and

BE IT FURTHER MOVED;

The King County Council requests that the Executive submit to the Operations, Police and Judiciary Committee his recommended criteria for phasing down the employment level, should a moderate reduction be required.
